The funeral will take place on Tuesday, 19th March and it is hoped that his son-in-law from the USA will be in time.

His daughter, Myra, was in Cape Town at the time of his death.

Rusoord, Vryburg, will remember the Joffe brothers, who donated furniture when it started. Harry Joffe will also be remembered by many of the under privileged whom he helped during his life time.

Harry Joffe came to Vryburg with very little and through his good business brain and hard work, he must surely have been one of the most successful businessmen we have had.

He is survived by his wife Ada and two children from his marriage to Anne.

children. Harry Joffe was born in Latvia on August 28, 1911 and he came to Vryburg in 1934 and left in 1959.

His wife Anne died in 1976 and in 1979 he married Dr Ada Muister of Cape Town. Actually they lived in Israel and were on one of their regular visits to Cape Town when he became ill and died after three days in hospital.

Harry Joffe was one of the charter members of the Vryburg Rotary Club which started in 1955. He was also a very active member of the Vryburg Chamber of Commerce.
